CONDITIONS

- 1) Mooring fees must be paid in full with application - a post dated cheque (April 1, 2017) is acceptable and that cheque will not be processed until a mooring has been confirmed to the applicant.
- 2) It is mandatory for all tenants to carry a minimum of \$2,000,000 public liability and property damage insurance as a condition of the mooring.

A copy of of your current insurance agreement must be submitted with this application.

- 3) If the boat is to be launched as part of the BHYC Spring Launch then we would remind you that the owner or representative must be present at launch and lifting points must be marked on your boat.
- 4) The term of this mooring agreement is between April 15, 2017 and October 31, 2017. Owners leaving their vessel in the harbour after October 31, 2017 must seek permission from the Town of Oakville Harbours staff. Owners leaving their vessel in the harbour after October 31, 2017 without permission shall do so at their own risk and

may be subject to additional charges in accordance with The Town of Oakville Harbour policies.

- 5) Upon failure to remove a vessel by November 15, 2017, The Town of Oakville Harbour staff may remove and store the vessel, or may use a third party. The Owner agrees all charges incurred for the removal and storage of the vessel are the sole responsibility of the Owner and shall be subject to the Repair and Storage Liens Act R.S.O 1990, C.R. 25.
- 6) The Slip holder shall not sublet, transfer or assign the mooring assigned to them by the club.
- 7) It is a condition of your mooring that your boat be licensed or registered in your name. To operate your boat in the harbour, the operator of your boat must have a valid operator's license where it is required by law.
- 8) Slip holders using shore power outlets should make themselves familiar with C.S.A. Standard C-22, No. 1831-M19A2.AC., Electrical installations on boats, and in particular Section 4.6 Shore Power Supply and 5.3 Shore Power Inlet Warning.
- 9) Transfer of fuel from a portable container to a boat's fuel tank is strictly prohibited.
- 10) Steps placed to assist boarding must not obstruct passage along the dock and must be securely fastened to the dock and limited to a maximum width of 18".
- 11) Mooring lines must be attached to the ring on the stern anchor tire by means of a shackle. Under no circumstances are the stern lines to be attached to the shackle that fastens the anchor tire to the ring.
