If there are no slips available guide them to the wall under the crane which is technically the visitor slip. Have all visitors sign in. Have them show proof of reciprocal privileges (most do) and they stay for free. Give them the visitor package. Now you can go back to sit on your boat until the next interesting person arrives.
