



#### Savings Available On 2017 Club Mooring

BHYC has moorings available for club members at a discount, providing a boat owner with a significant savings in 2017.

The rates for 2017 are as follows:

25 foot boat or less is	\$39.80 per foot
26 foot boat is	\$40.57 per foot
27 foot boat is	\$41.34 per foot
28 foot boat is	\$42.12 per foot
29 foot boat is	\$42.89 per foot
30 foot boat is	\$43.66 per foot

The Town's assessment for TOWARF of \$26.52 plus HST must be added into your calculations.

These slips are on the west side of the river (across from the crane) and are available on a first come basis. The 2017 rate provides you with a 25% savings when compared with the Town's cost.

This opportunity is only available until March 15, 2017. You must have your applications in by then. After March 15, the slips go to first come first serve.

The boat, cradle, 9.9 outboard and equipment therein are included and are being sold "AS IS, WHERE IS".


Bronte Harbour Yacht Club makes no guarantee or warranty as to the condition of the items for sale.



#### Obituary for Margaret Jones (Life Member)


