

BHYC Addendum # 2 to Club Racing on Thursdays and Sundays.

Notice to all racers in the BHYC Thursday and Sunday Series!

Effective July 21-2021, the racing offered by BHYC may come in either of the 2 formats you are all familiar with. They may be either fixed mark or windward leeward using marks set by the mark boat GreyDawn. The reason for this is to add variety and challenge to appeal to a broader set of racers. It is important to understand BHYC is historically a very competitive racing club, and fixed mark was originally a compromise solution to get us through COVID restrictions.

Therefore, the SI's you already have are amended in these sections:

10. Courses

10.1 Courses shall be laid out using either the fixed marks as listed in Appendix 1

i) or using marks set out on race day under the direction of the RO and Race Committee

ii) or a combination of fixed marks from Appendix 1 and orange inflatable tetrahedral marks deployed by the mark boat.

11. Marks

11.1 As per Appendix 1 and / or in combination with orange tetrahedrals.

Other comments as related to racing

The goal here is to offer a good mix to try and keep our racers challenged and engaged with the club. Please expect that whenever possible it will usually be fixed on Sundays and windward-leeward on Thursdays. You should also expect a short survey (Y/N) to gauge interest in a Tuesday night series be added as well. If there is demand, we need to be quick about setting it up, so please respond to the survey promptly.
